

**Free Dress Days:** will be scheduled periodically throughout the school year. Whenever possible advance notice will be given via the school newsletter or communication via classroom teacher. Children are to dress modestly, with clothing and accessories that will not detract attention from the business of learning. As a Catholic School, Holy Redeemer has expectations for student attire on free dress days. Our goal is for all students to be comfortable, respectful, and safe even on non-uniform days.

**Guidelines for Free Dress Days for all Grades:**

Shoes need to have a back

Jewelry should not cause a distraction or safety issue

Hats, scarves and sunglasses are to be worn outside only

Hair color should be kept natural and away from face

Clothes should be free of holes or tears

No sweats, camo clothing or athletic shorts shorter than 2" above the knee

Shirts and blouses should be long enough to completely cover the stomach and back area

Shirts, dresses or blouses should have sleeves and appropriate necklines

Faces should be clean and free of makeup

Leggings or tights may only be worn under skirts or shorts

Clothing should be appropriately sized with no tight or excessively large clothing

Shirts must be free of inappropriate messaging or advertisements (i.e. alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, violence or allude to sex)

***It is at the discretion of the classroom teacher and /or administration to decide if a student has failed to follow these guidelines. Students may be asked to change into a uniform.***
